CALL FOR POSTERS

To enhance the networking opportunities and expand the number of stories shared, the Pioneer Network invites attendees to submit a proposal for a poster at the Pioneer Network Pioneering a New Culture of Aging Conference that will be held in Denver, CO August 12 - August 15, 2018.

Not prepared with a lot of statistics and research? Sure, we'd like to see some posters with this kind of data, but it doesn't have to be "scientific" to be worth sharing with your fellow pioneers. Use your creativity in telling your story – that's all that's required. Story-telling on a poster!

Ideas for topics include:

- Organizational practices that support person-directed care for elders and/or empowerment and engagement of staff that provide care for elders
- Best practices that support person directed care forelders
- Environmental approaches to support person-directed care for elders
- Supporting relationships between elders needing care and support and those providing that care and support
- QAPI projects or measurement of person-directed care (individual or at the organizational level)
- Person-directed care and the tension between autonomy and risk
- Consumer engagement and education about person-directed care
- Evaluation of person directed models of care
- Business case for person-directed care

Proposals will be accepted until June 1, 2018.

If you agree to present your poster, you are responsible for paying the cost of the conference registration. Presenters are welcome to have someone at your poster during designated Gallery hours, you will be required to have someone available to share your poster content on Tuesday August 13 from 11:30 – 1:00.

Poster presentations will be displayed on 6ft x 3ft tables. (1-2 per table based on space requirements)
