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1. Complete the Pioneer Network: Exploring the Future: Finding Meaning & Purpose
  - a. Attendance during the live event on September 22 will be validated using Zoom report of time in sessions.
  - b. Attendance at sessions viewed on-demand will be validated through reports of sign-in on the attendee only website.
2. Upon completion of the courses (up to 5 sessions / CEUs), you will need to complete a general program quiz and Course Evaluation. You can complete this electronically by clicking on the link provided on the attendee website under the How to Earn CEs section.
