### **Instructions to Receive Nursing Contact Hours**

- 1. Attend and/or view on-demand Pioneer Network: Exploring the Future: More to Do in 2022! Symposium sessions.**
  - a. Attendance during the live event on December 8 will be validated using Zoom report of time in sessions.
  - b. Attendance at sessions viewed on-demand will be validated through reports of sign-in on the attendee only website.
- 2. Upon completion of the courses (up to 5 sessions / CEUs), you will need to complete a general program quiz and Course Evaluation.**
  - a. The Quiz / Course Eval will be completed electronically. A link will be emailed to attendees following the live symposium on December 8, and then it will be on the attendee website under the How to Earn CEUs section starting on December 10.
  - b. The quiz must be completed with a score of 70% or greater. (If needed, you will have the ability to retake the quiz.)
